“Adopting” your local CVC by supporting its fundraising projects and assisting in one or more of the following ways:

- Sterilising pets at your private practice for your local CVC at a reduced fee
- Raising funds at your private practice for your local CVC
- Donating R5 to your local CVC for each pet that you vaccinate at your private practice
- Donating R10 to your local CVC for each neuter/spay that you do at your private practice
- By assisting with the administration or coordination of a CVC sterilisation campaign in your vicinity
- By providing transportation for pets from disadvantage communities to private practices that participate in this project for the local CVC
