Classic love stories over a Romantic picnic

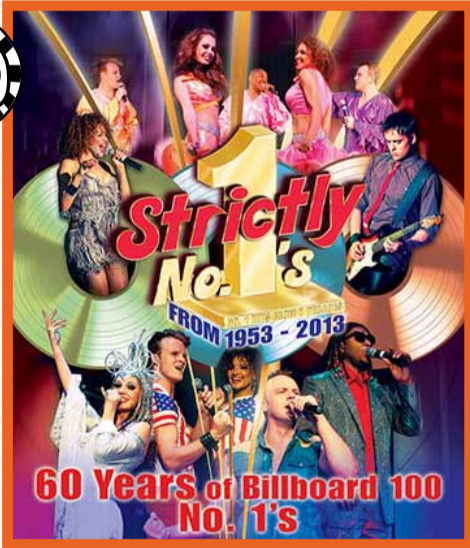
