BIZANA CVC: OUR FIRST EVER EXCLUSIVELY EQUINE CVC!



Glen Austin Equine Clinic and Bosch Hoek Equine Hospital joined forces to vaccinate ponies in the Bizana area, KwaZulu-Natal. This was supported by the AHS (African Horse Sickness) Trust, which donated the first 400 vaccines.

Helen Tiffin (of Bosch Hoek Equine Hospital) and Dr. Rissa Parker (Glen Austin Equine Clinic) set off over the weekend of 23/24 August for their fourth trip to Bizana to vaccinate the horses/ponies in the area against AHS. They were ably assisted by Sharon Rodgers and Megan Frost who helped mix vaccines, fill in passports (donated by MSD) and ran "the shop". They vaccinated 250 ponies and provided some primary health care.

Post the August 2013 outreach, Dr Parker decided to formalise the project by establishing a CVC. The Bizana Project CVC was registered in May 2014.

WHERE IS BIZANA?

Located 70km inland from Port Edward heading towards Kokstad in beautiful country! Often many of the owners and young children ride across country, sometimes for 2 hours, to have their ponies vaccinated.



CHALLENGE:

The AHS Trust won't be sponsoring vaccines anymore so we would need to raise money to purchase more for the next scheduled outreach for October 2014. This will be the 1st outreach under the CVC umbrella. Would you consider sponsoring a vaccine for R140?
